If you were one of the 600,000 people that went to Daytona for Bike Week 2000. You know the weather was great. And there were to many thing to do, or go see in a week or two. I know I didn't get to see everything that was going on.

I can tell you what happen at the drag race in Orlando Speed World, here's a recap. Over 200 driver were ready to go racing at Orlando Speed World on March 7 & 8, Also there were standing room only left for fans to watch.

Lets start with **Top Fuel** - 22 Top Fuel competitors - showed up for the annual event. The winner for the second straight year went to **Dale Nungesser**, Winning time was **7.153 seconds** (179.71 mph).

In Pro Fuel - Larry Brancaccio's "**Drums**", won with a time of **7.550 seconds** at 162.39 mph. But he was running Johnny Kool's bike. See early the day before Johnny crash and Drums ran down to the finish line as Johnny Kool was laying on a stretcher in pain because he had broken four ribs, and Drums talk Johnny into letting him ride his bike. Johnny Kool was happy about the win. because his week end wasn't a total lost after all. Drums was no stranger, to this bike. Because this was his bike two seasons ago.

Pro Drag - I'm sure you all know by now I was the one who thrill the crowd, by crashing my new Pro Drag bike, I am ok, **THANKS to VANSONS LEATHERS** that save my skin. And my new gloves that was custom made to my hand, I didn't even break a finger nails. **THANKS AGAIN VANSON LEATHERS** for the **best leathers in the world**. And I'm proof of that. No road rash at all on me. But I did Trash the bike. It's a total lost, I feel sorry for Marc my Husband, he work so hard on that bike. I'm sorry Marc. What we have seen in the tapes, I smoke the tire real bad. And when the front wheel came down and unloaded the back it was spinning, and the tire came wright out from under me. I thought I could ride it out, like I have done with my Pro stock bike, but you can't with a NITRO bike, I should of lifted. Now to the winner of the class Marc Augustine who beat Drums by four-tenths of a second winning pass was 164.44 mph in 7.687 seconds. Drums almost won in two class.

Pro Stock - David Feazell took the win when Dirk Higgins red-lighted in the final run. Feazell's ride was over in 7.856 seconds, at 164.41 mph

Pro Gas - Gary Stroud winning time was 8.744 seconds, at 140.36 mph over Ken Browne
